

Volunteers served over 8,000 meals last year. Each Tuesday, about 120 of our neighbors join us for dinner! We hit an attendance record of 245 people served one week in November. We also had the opportunity to feed 70 first responders when they were working a river rescue.

MASTER LEASE

We are working with ReVi Hotel in New Cumberland to negotiate a 5 room Master Lease. Our goal launch date is September 2025. The purpose of this project is to provide physical and spiritual stability through transitional housing. This project will be financed through grants and individual giving. We will be training individuals and couples to be mentors to these families. These families will be families that we serve at Dinner Church who do not qualify for traditional shelters.

WAREHOUSE

Bread of Life Warehouse is the warehouse where we get a lot of food and products to facilitate Dinner Church. Our church will support the warehouse on a monthly basis.
