LOOKING AHEAD!

Roof Project/ Steeple - We are praising God for providing for us before we need the provision. We are looking to replace the church roof in the next few months. To prevent the issues we are currently having with the roof, the project will include removing the steeple.

Convoy Food Boxes/Missions Team - This summer, we have the opportunity to partner with Convoy of Hope again to distribute groceries to Hillside Elementary School. Our Convoy Missionaries will be with us on May 3. We will have a Compassion training and Leadership meeting after church with lunch!

The Missions team from Ohio will once again join us this June to serve at Dinner Church, help with the Convoy boxes, and assist with some other projects.

Dinner Church - We continue to build relationships in our community each week through dinner church! We have a new church helping us once a month. In addition, the women's recovery house, Sadler Health, Community Cares, Free Swap, and Starfish Ministries join us monthly to assist.
